TUPELO – Upgraded voting machines will be in use at Lee County precincts beginning with this summer's primary races.

The county's election commissioners convened Tuesday morning to examine new scanning machines that will be used to count paper ballots.

"I'm just thrilled Lee County has stepped into the modern age," said Shelia Landsell, election commissioner for District 2. Things won't change all that much. Voters will still mark their selections on a paper ballot, a feature the Lee County Board of Supervisors has been very keen to retain.

JACKSON – More questions are being raised about the party loyalties of How ard Sherman, who is running as a Democrat for the Mississippi U.S. Senate seat now held by Republican Roger Wicker. Jackson lawyer Sam Begley on Tuesday provided The Associated Press with a California voter registration document showing Sherman registered as a Republican there and voted in the 2012 and 2016 Republican presidential primaries. Sherman campaign manager Giles Perkins said Sherman was registered as a Republican because the California Democratic Party wasn't a good ideological fit for a businessman like Sherman.

MDEQ investigating work at Pinnacle Point site

TUPELO – Site work being done on a potential \$50 million project in Tupelo has drawn the attention of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality.

The agency confirmed a complaint was filed related to the Pinnacle Point development on North Gloster Street.

"An investigator from our regional office will be at the site today," said MDEQ spokesman Robbie Wilbur on Wednesday.

lined his plans for a senior living community, retail stores and restaurants as part of the development. The project would encompass about 28 acres stretching from the west side of North Gloster Street – where a Comfort Suites hotel and a Sleep Inn hotel were located prior to being destroyed by the April 2014 tornado – toward Legion Lake.

Initial plans call for an \$18 million investment in a senior living facility called Pinnacle Point of Tupelo.

Fusion Hospitality owned the Comfort Suites, and Patel later bought the lot where Sleep Inn was located. Neither hotel was rebuilt.
