# More than 18,000 votes cast in UC

UNION COUNTY - From Thursday, Oct. 15 to Saturday, Oct. 17, early voting totals jumped from 7,224 to 18,811 or 38.4% in Union County, according to the county Board of Elections.

At the end of the day on Friday (Oct. 16), 7,552 voters were counted and then an additional 4,035 voters were counted on Saturday on top of the 7,224 voters that were counted on Thursday.

On Friday, Marvin Ridge High, Mineral Springs Volunteer Fire Department. and Monroe High School had the largest count of voters with more than 1,000 voters each.

On Saturday, Monroe High School, Stallings Volunteer Fire Department and Hemby Bridge had the largest turnout; however, the numbers dipped between 550 and 630 voters, according to the county Board of Elections.
